Q1 If the candidates for US Senate this fall were Democrat John Hickenlooper and Republican Cory Gardner, who would you vote for?

John Hickenlooper 51%
Cory Gardner 42%

Q2 Do you support or oppose background checks on all gun sales, which would close loopholes in the federal law that currently make it easier for dangerous people to buy guns at gun shows and online without a background check?
